The regular Council meeting was called to order.

The agenda was reviewed. A motion was made by Fliss to approve the agenda. The motion was seconded by Meyer. All voted in favor. None voted against. The motion was carried.

Minutes from the January 13th meeting were reviewed. A motion was made by Renaas and seconded by Hanson to approve the minutes from the January 13th meeting with corrections. All voted in favor. None voted against. The motion was carried.

The Planning Commission recommendation was reviewed. A motion was made by Hanson and seconded by Renaas to approve the variance for 414 Lac Qui Parle Ave N. All voted in favor. None voted against. The motion was carried.

Chief Diekmann brought in a new patch request. He worked with the High School art class to come up with ideas for a new patch. Lucas Groenhoff was the winner of the patch design. With this change he is looking for a change in the uniform policy to change from the powder blue to a navy-blue top. This would mean re-issuing the initial 2 long sleeve and 2 short sleeve shirts. A motion was made by Fliss to approve the changes in the uniform policy. The motion was seconded by Hanson. All voted in favor. None voted against. The motion was carried.

A motion was made by Meyer and seconded by AJ to purchase the initial issued shirts and allowing officers to wear carriers. All voted in favor. None voted against. The motion was carried.

A motion was made by Fliss and seconded by Hanson to purchase 200 fully stitched patches at a cost of \$480.00 plus shipping and give recognition to Lucas Groenhoff for his work on the design. All voted in favor. None voted against. The motion was carried.

Chief Diekmann brought a request to purchase 2 new rifles for the squads. The one he was looking at is a LE SBR part number LE-001. A motion was made by Hanson and seconded by Meyer to purchase 2-part numbers LE-001 with the red dot. All voted in favor. None voted against. The motion was carried.

Chief Diekmann also had a department update including sharing that he did a survey with his officers on how things are going and sending out ordinance violations.

The camping rates for the parks were discussed. A motion was made by Hanson and seconded by Renaas to raise the rates to \$20.00 per night. All voted in favor. None voted against. The motion was carried.

The vendor transactions for January were reviewed. A motion was made by Renaas and seconded by Hanson to approve the vendor transactions in the amount of \$1,796,132.99. All voted in favor. None voted against. The motion was carried.

A motion was made by Fliss to adjourn the meeting. The motion was seconded by Meyer. All voted in favor. None voted against. The motion was carried.
