The regular Council meeting was called to order.

The agenda was reviewed. A motion was made by Cram and seconded by Kack to approve the agenda as presented. All voted in favor. None voted against. The motion was carried.

The council minutes from the June 9th meeting were reviewed. A motion was made by Kack and seconded by Cram to approve the minutes. All voted in favor. None voted against. The motion was carried.

A motion was made by Bueltel and seconded by Cram to appoint Nancy Bormann as Mayor until after the 1st regular meeting in November. All voted in favor. None voted against. The motion was carried.

A motion was made by Kack and seconded by Bueltel to approve the 2026 council designations due to the change of removing Susan Cram from the Airport Board and assigning Rick Bueltel to the Airport Board. All voted in favor. None voted against. The motion was carried.

A motion was made by Fliss and seconded by Kack to approve the list of August primary election judges. All voted in favor. None voted against. The motion was carried.

A motion was made by Cram and seconded by Bueltel to introduce Ordinance 272.1 Mayor & Council Pay. All voted in favor. None voted against. The motion was carried.

A motion was made by Bueltel and seconded by Kack to introduce Ordinance 251C Airport Board. All voted in favor. None voted against. The motion was carried.

June vendor transactions were reviewed. A motion was made by Bueltel and seconded by Kack to approve the June vendor transactions in the amount of \$840,510.42. All voted in favor. None voted against. The motion was carried.

An administrator's report was provided.

Discussion was had regarding golf carts. There have been issues with people driving on sidewalks and through parks and reports of underaged drivers. Law enforcement will work on enforcing the golf cart ordinance more strictly.

A motion was made by Kack and seconded by Cram to go into closed session per MN Stat. 13D.03, subd 1(b) Labor negotiations. All voted in favor. None voted against. The motion was carried.

Closed session was had.

After discussion, the council had agreed to offer city administrator, Bonnie Merritt, a 4.5% increase totaling a salary of \$99,700.00. An official contract will be approved at the next meeting.

A motion was made by Bueltel and seconded by Fliss to adjourn the meeting. All voted in favor. None voted against. The motion was carried.
