The regular Council meeting was called to order.

The agenda was reviewed. A motion was made by Cram and seconded by Bueltel to approve the agenda as presented. All voted in favor. None voted against. The motion was carried.

The council minutes from the July 21st meeting were reviewed. A motion was made by Bueltel and seconded by Cram to approve the minutes. All voted in favor. None voted against. The motion was carried.

Matt Wagner was present to discuss converting the jet fuel tank at the airport to avgas due to lack of use. After discussion, a motion was made by Bueltel and seconded by Cram to allow Matt to give away the remaining jet fuel to a local pilot at no cost and to table the conversion until more information is provided and the project is budgeted. All voted in favor. None voted against. The motion was carried.

The MN Small Cities Organization was discussed. This topic was tabled until more information is provided.

Council meeting dates were discussed for the upcoming new year. This will be discussed again as the new year approaches.

Motorized vehicles in prohibited areas were discussed. After discussion, the council requested that the police monitor and enforce the ordinance.

July vendor transactions in the amount of \$271,984.68 were reviewed. A payment in the amount of \$11,050.00 was made to Fuller Paving. There was a mistake in the invoice so the existing check will be voided, and a new check will be issued for \$10,350.00. A motion was made by Cram and seconded by Bueltel to approve the July vendor transactions and voiding and reissuing the check to Fuller Paving. All voted in favor. None voted against. The motion was carried.
