The regular Council meeting was called to order.

The agenda was reviewed. A motion was made by Kack and seconded by Cram to approve the agenda as presented. All voted in favor. None voted against. The motion was carried.

The council minutes from the August 18th meeting were reviewed. A motion was made by Fliss and seconded by Bueltel to approve the minutes. All voted in favor. None voted against. The motion was carried.

Fire Chief Chance Anseeuw was present to discuss the purchase of a 2026 Freightliner tanker truck equipped with a 2,000-gallon tank and a 750 GPM pump. He stated that the upgraded pump capacity would enhance the firefighting effectiveness and may contribute to an improved ISO rating for the community. This purchase would replace the 1989 unit that is beginning to fail as the tank is leaking and rust and debris is accumulating in the drop tanks. This apparatus would be purchased without the use of city funds and would be paid in full with the use of funds from the Canby Fire Relief Association. After further discussion, a motion was made by Fliss and seconded by Bueltel to approve the purchase of this unit from Heiman Fire Equipment in the amount of \$354,550.00 and to allow the sale of the 1989 unit. Cram, Bueltel, and Fliss voted in favor. Kack abstained. The motion was carried.

A 2027 tobacco agreement with Countryside Public Health was reviewed. A motion was made by Kack and seconded by Cram to approve the agreement. All voted in favor. None voted against. The motion was carried.

An administrator's report was provided.

A motion was made by Bueltel and seconded by Kack to adjourn the meeting. All voted in favor. None voted against. The motion was carried.
